NOTICE

All students are hereby informed that the “**Brikhya Bandhu–Plant, Protect and Prosper**” initiative, under the “**Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam 2026**” scheme is being undertaken jointly by the Forest Department and Education Department to promote a large-scale, people-centric afforestation movement through the active participation of students.

Under this initiative, students of Class VI and above are designated as “**Brikhya Bandhu**” and are encouraged to actively participate in plantation and environmental conservation.

Each participating student is expected to:

1. Adopt and establish six (6) seedlings at a site of his/her choice.
2. Undertake the plantation of the seedlings during the stipulated period.
3. Protect and maintain the planted seedlings for a period of six months.
4. Regularly monitor the growth and survival of the seedlings.
5. Upload **geo-tagged photographs** through the designated mobile application/portal as evidence of plantation and maintenance.
6. Complete the prescribed reporting activities within the given timelines.

Successful completion of the first geo-tagged photograph upload will entitle the participating student to receive an online digital certificate.
